ADDITIONAL FEES & DISCOUNTS:

- **EQUIPMENT & STOCK FEE:** All High School Film and Photography Programs have an additional equipment fee of \$250/wk (Digital Photography is \$200/wk). Acting, Dance and Youth Programs (including Youth Film & Photo) do not incur this fee.
- **ROOM & BOARD:** Tuition does not include Room & Board (see page 16 for details). Room & Board for our New York and Los Angeles Campuses is \$595/wk. Room & Board in Vermont is \$525/wk.
- **DAMAGE DEPOSIT:** All programs require a \$250 damage deposit that will be refunded within two weeks from program's end date. Any incidental charges like lost room key fees will be taken out of the damage deposit before it is refunded.
- **MULTI-SESSION DISCOUNT:** Receive 5% off each tuition fee for two or more sessions or siblings under one account.

POLICIES

ENROLLMENT & ADDITIONAL FORMS

After we receive your application, deposit, and recent school report card/transcript, we will contact you by mail within two weeks to confirm your enrollment with an acceptance letter, invoice, and information about your online account. Shortly following acceptance, we will mail you our summer information packet and release and consent form. The information packet contains important information about the program and activities, arrival and departure, staying at SOCAPA, what to bring, and student responsibilities. The release and consent form must be completed and signed by student and parent/s or legal guardian/s. In addition, we require that you submit health and travel information. We request that you do this through your online account. If you have any questions about the forms and information above, please contact us. Final acceptance to the program is contingent upon SOCAPA's receipt and review of all forms and information.

SUPERVISION

The number one priority at the School of Cinema and Performing Arts is the safety and well being of our students. SOCAPA has a full staff of qualified supervisors on-duty at all times during the program. All of our counselors and teaching assistants are at least twenty-one years of age and have strong leadership skills and experience. Most have degrees in either visual or performing arts from prestigious universities and many have been through Residence Assistant training programs.

On evenings and weekends when students are not in class or on shoots, SOCAPA provides a full schedule of activities until 10pm (these activities are mandatory for youth and high school programs; pre-college participants can choose to participate in these activities or not). Students must be in their rooms for check-in at 10:30pm and lights-out is at 11:00pm. Our supervisors will make rounds and conduct sporadic room checks after lights-out to make sure the students remain in their rooms. There will be at least one SOCAPA resident supervisor and one SOCAPA resident director on-duty per dormitory building. Students are not allowed in the dormitory rooms of members of the opposite sex unless there is a SOCAPA supervisor present.

Off-Campus Privileges (High School and Pre-College programs only): SOCAPA students have limited amounts of personal time during the program. Generally, they have short periods of downtime after classes but before dinner, and after dinner but before the evening activity. There is also some scheduled free time on weekends, particularly on Sunday mornings. Most students use this time to catch up on sleep, to do laundry, and to write and rehearse. SOCAPA allows students to use part of this downtime to explore the area surrounding the campus in order to scout for prospective locations or to shop for props, costumes or personal items. Students must meet/adhere to all of the following requirements/rules in order to leave campus grounds without a SOCAPA supervisor: 1) They must follow our "buddy system" and have another SOCAPA student with them AT ALL TIMES. They are never to go off on their own. 2) They must notify someone by signing out in our campus office as to where they are going, why, and when we can expect them back. 3) Upon return, students must sign back in with the office. 4) Students are responsible for knowing by when they must return. If students return later than expected or return late for class/evening meeting/curfew, etc., the off-campus privilege may be revoked.

Students are not permitted to leave the campus area without a SOCAPA Buddy or supervisor unless they have the prior written consent of parent/guardian. If parent/guardian would like to sign out a student for any period of time, we require that a letter of consent be written, signed and faxed (or e-mailed) to our office detailing to whom we should release the student, when they should be released and for how long, and a contact number where the student will be. Students must notify a supervisor upon departure and return. Students must be back no later than check-in (10:30pm) unless spending the entire night (10:30pm – 8:00am) off campus.

PAYMENT POLICY: DEPOSIT, TUITION, CANCELLATION & REFUNDS

A non-refundable, \$500 deposit is required to secure a spot in all of SOCAPA's Summer Programs. The final tuition balance is due no later than May 1. If we have not received payment by this date, SOCAPA reserves the right to cancel unpaid applicants with no return of fees. Prior to April 1, all tuition, except the \$500 deposit, is fully refundable. For cancellations between April 1 and May 1, we will refund 50% of the tuition and fees. After May 1, there are no refunds, except in the form of camp credit. For this reason, SOCAPA highly recommends that students secure travel insurance to cover trip cancellation, interruption and/or medical emergency. SOCAPA reserves the right to cancel any program before its start date. In the unlikely event that cancellation should occur, you have the option of a complete refund or transfer to another program. Registrant waives any and all damages that may otherwise arise out of any program cancellation and agrees to accept as liquidated damages said registration fees. We highly discourage making non-refundable or non-changeable travel arrangements to and from our programs.
